c.) MTBA programs

Discussion on what can be done to incentivize people to invest in MA thoroughbred breeding. Suggestions included increasing the purse supplements but we still need more horses to run. Also, current law has cap limits on the amount of awards in races. Incentives have to begin with the breeding

Suggested 2025 Breeding Program

- 1. Award \$25,000 to lesee or owner to bring a new stallion into MA.
- 2. Award the farm where stallion will stand \$25,000 in form of a grant.
- 3. Cap at 3 new stallions entering the state
- 4. Award owner or lesee \$7500 for mares entering MA before Oct 15 and \$7500 when the foal drops
- 5. Award owner or lesee \$7500 for mares entering after October 15 and \$2500 to breed back to MA stallion
- 6. Award farms \$1000 for each foal dropped
- 7. Award \$2500 to mare owner or lesee for breed back to a MA stallion
- 8. Cap at 25 new mares entering the state
